- adapted to the particularities of a papertape;

- should a record always end with a NL character ?
- what should be the standard length of a record ?
- should this length be calculated in number of EBCDIC or PTTC/8 characters ?

- if there are potential users of Algol I/O for 1134/1055;
- and what is expected of such system.
